Big Brothers Big Sisters of Greater Pittsburgh	Big Brothers Big Sisters of Greater Pittsburgh's youth mentoring program, after implementation, will decrease the incidences of aggressive and violent behaviors in underrepresented students who attend elementary, middle, and high-schools located in some of the most distressed and underserved areas. Allegheny Township Police Department	The Allegheny Township Police Department's TASERs are currently nine years old and the requested funding would allow the department to obtain new TASERs and the required training and upkeep that comes with them.	Blair County PA	\$61
Warminster Township Police Department	The funding aims to address critical technology and infrastructure needs within the Warminster Township Police Department. City of Wilkes-Barre	The acquisition of vehicles will be assigned to the community policing officers and to the proactive sweeps that are utilized to target high crime areas. Northampton County	This funding request includes a combination of hardware, software, and services to expand the existing P25 public safety communications network.
